

Public Notice #2

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Louisiana State Museum to owners of property as listed below, that has been on deposit, loan, or otherwise with the Louisiana State Museum, located at 751 Chartres Street, New Orleans, Louisiana for more than ten (10) years and to which no person has made a claim. Pursuant to Louisiana Statute 25:345, any such property shall vest in the Museum if no valid claim to such property is presented to the Museum within sixty-five (65) days from this date.

In accordance with Louisiana Revised Statute 25:345 (c)(2), the following list of owners of record, along with a description of the property to be deemed abandoned, are listed:

1. **Schwartz Eustis & Co.**; address unknown; monument
2. **Nola Radio Co.**; G.A. DeCortin, address unknown; radio
3. **Saenger Amusement Co. / Saenger Theatre, Inc.**; through Richards, address unknown; photograph of Ferdinand Foch
4. **U.S. Spanish American War Veterans**; Baton Rouge, address unknown; flag
5. **United Confederate Veterans**; through Mrs. W. Booth, address unknown War relics
6. **New Orleans Academy of Sciences**; unknown address; constitution and by laws of org. and a list of books

If proof of claim is not presented by the owner to the museum and if the owner's right to receive such property is not established to the satisfaction of the Louisiana State Museum within sixty-five days from the date of the second published notice, the property will be deemed to be abandoned and shall become the property of the Louisiana State Museum.
