MOBILIZING THE HOME FRONT, 1941**Investigation**

How did Louisiana's government officials mobilize support for our nation's war efforts during World War II?

Artifacts:

Process**Ask students to**

1. Read the document and make a list of the government war agencies that were active in Louisiana during World War I.
2. Prepare a graphic organizer that illustrates their findings.
3. View the World War I Propaganda Posters in the LOUISiana Digital Library at [War posters--American--1910-1920](#). Make a list of the features that enable these posters to shape/influence public opinion effectively.
4. Select one government war agency that was active in Louisiana and plan a campaign to further the goals of that agency.
 - a. Use the ideas they gain from the World War I posters to prepare a **WWII Propaganda Poster** to accomplish the goal of their specific agency.
 - b. Prepare a brief public relations speech to use with the poster to boost support for their agency.
